HSU Recycling Team Services

► COMPOST

Food scraps, coffee grounds, tea bags, uncoated paper plates and napkins. **Pizza boxes at HSU should also be composted!**

► REUSE OFFICE SUPPLY EXCHANGE (ROSE)

Free office supplies @ the Warren House, run by the students of WRRAP. For hours of operation and how to donate or pick up items, check wrrap.humboldt.edu/rose

► CAMPUS WALL

Buy, trade, or sell items via a secure website specific to only HSU stakeholders. (It's like an HSU-specific Craigslist!) humboldt.mycampuswall.com

► MIXED RECYCLING

Paper, cardboard, bottles, cans, plastics #1-5, metals.

► Oh SNAP! FOOD PANTRY & THRIFT SHOP

Access to food resources and CalFresh application assistance. Thrift Shop offers repurposed clothing and room furnishings. For locations and hours go to hsuohsnap.org or follow us on Instagram @[hsuohsnap](https://www.instagram.com/hsuohsnap)

► OTHER REQUIRED RECYCLING

Batteries, CFL's, CD's, printer cartridges, electronics — use only special receptacles located at BSS, UC, Library and CC Mailroom

► LANDFILL WASTE

Anything you can't donate, compost or recycle.

In 2019 HSU landfilled 530 tons of trash, the same weight as 40 school buses.
